Mrs A. Corson, trainer of **REBEL WOMAN** running in the fifth race requested that the horse be allowed to go post early and if needed, be led in. The Stewards considered the request and duly granted it. The Stewards Secretary informed the Starter.

Immediately after the running of the third race the Stewards called an enquiry into the start and whether or not **COPPER FALLS**, trained by Mr. B. Powell and ridden by Mr. M. Lawson had been given an unfair advantage when led in. Following a review of the tape it was concluded that it had not been given an unfair advantage. The trainer was also interviewed as to why he had not sought permission from the Stewards for the horse to be led in. Mr. Powell explained that the horse had seemed nervous in the chute and he had sought permission from the Clerk of the Course and the Starter for it to be led in. The Stewards were satisfied that the correct course of action had been adhered to and no further action was taken.
