The Stewards gave the Clerk of the Course permission for the first hurdle in the opening race to be removed due to weather conditions.

Mrs A. Corson, trainer of **REBEL WOMAN**, running in the third, requested permission to go to post early and mount in the chute or on course if required to do so. Mr K. Kukk, trainer of **HERBALIST** requested permission to go straight to post and not parade. The Stewards considered the requests and duly granted permission. The Stewards Secretary duly informed the Starter, who also confirmed his consent.

The Stewards noted a change in colours of **LEYLAND** trained by Mrs N. Lloyd-Beavis, running in the last.

The trainer Mr. J Moon was unable to find a jockey for his mount **POMANDER**, declared in the fourth race and therefore had no option but to withdraw it. The Stewards noted his explanation but as per rules duly fined him £50.

Race 1 – 2.30pm. THE CPA HURDLE

The Stewards enquired into the running of **BECK'S BOLERO**, trained by Mrs A. Corson, ridden by Mr F. Tett, placed fourth having gone off as favourite. The trainer reported that the horse was unsuited to the ground. The Stewards noted the explanation and took no further action.

Race 2 – 3.05pm. THE RAVENSCROFT BIG BUCK'S SPRINT

The Stewards enquired into the late arrival in the Parade Ring of **MOVEMENTNEVERLIES**, trained by Mr. K. Kukk. The trainer apologised but reported that he had struggled to attach a tongue tie to the horse, who had in the process managed to unsaddle itself. He therefore had to re-saddle as well as make sure the tongue tie was fitted correctly. The Stewards noted his explanation and took no further action.

Race 3 – 3.40pm. THE 2015 JERSEY DERBY

The Stewards ordered the winner of the race, **AUSSIE LYRICS**, trained by Mrs C. Gilbert, ridden by Mr F. Tett to be routine tested. The sample was taken by Miss R Wood, Veterinary Surgeon and witnessed by the Stewards, Mr P. Edwards and Mr R. Whittle.

Race 4 – 4.15pm. THE ANIMAL HEALTH TRUST CELEBRATION MILE

The Stewards enquired into the running of **GUNPOWDER GERTIE**, trained by Mr J. Moon, ridden by Mr T. Marett. The trainer reported that it was the horses first time out and it wasn't as fit as it could have been. The Stewards considered his explanation and explained
