Prior to racing :

The Stewards continued the enquiry into interference in the third race held on 29th August 2016. Having heard evidence from Mr Philip Prince, rider of **HAWAIIAN FREEZE**, and viewed the recording of the race the Stewards fined the jockey £50 for careless riding. He was reminded that he should not have left the course without informing the Stewards Secretary, even if, as confirmed by his trainer, he had a flight to catch.

Mrs A. Corson, trainer of **REBEL WOMAN**, running in the second, requested permission to go to post early and mount in the chute or on course if required to do so. The Stewards considered the requests and duly granted permission. The Stewards Secretary informed the Starter of the requests, who also confirmed his consent.

The Stewards Secretary reported that the routine test ordered on the winner of the Clarendon, **HAWAIIAN FREEZE**, had come back negative for any prohibited substances and that the trainer Mr J. Moon had been duly informed.

Race 1 – 2.30pm. THE MILLBROOK SUMMER HANDICAP SPRINT

The Stewards ordered the first placed horse to be routine tested.

Race 2 – 3.05pm. THE HUMBER RACING & BLOODSTOCK HANDICAP

No Stewards Enquiry.

Race 3 – 3.40pm. THE FIR-PINE DEVELOPMENT HANDICAP HURDLE SERIES FINAL

The Stewards enquired into possible interference between **JAZZY LADY**, ridden by Ms Lucy Gardner, trained by Mrs S. Gardner, placed first and **FOURNI**, ridden by Mr M. Batchelor, trained by Mrs A. Malzard, placed second at or around the furlong mark. Having heard evidence and viewed recordings of the race, they took no further action. The Stewards also interviewed Mrs A. Malzard as to the improvement in form or **FOURNI**, she reported that it was the first time out for the horse in a visor and that had obviously worked. The Stewards noted the explanation.

Race 4 – 4.15pm. THE RAVENSCROFT HANDICAP

The Stewards interviewed the trainer Mr J. Moon and the rider, Miss E. Wilford as to the poor performance of **INFORMALITY**, the trainer and jockey in separate interviews confirmed that the horse was unsuited by the going. The Stewards noted the explanation.

Race 5 – 4.50pm. THE HUNSCOTE STUD BREEDING SUCCESS HANDICAP MILE

The rider of **GRANIT MAN**, Miss E. Wilford reported that her saddle had slipped and she therefore no choice but to pull up.
