Prior to racing: Mrs J. Coomer trainer of **TORETTO**, running in the first and Mrs A. Malzard, trainer of **LARCH**, running in the third, requested that their charges be allowed in to the Parade Ring last, be first out and mounted in the chute or on course if required to do so. The Stewards considered the requests and duly granted permission.

Mr. K. Kukk, trainer of **ORDER OF SERVICE**, running in the second, requested that his horse be allowed to go to post the “long way round”. The Stewards considered the request and duly granted permission.

Race 1 – 2.30pm. THE LADBROKES BETSTATION HANDICAP HURDLE

The Stewards enquired into the performance of **STEELY**, trained by Mr K. Kukk, ridden by Mr P. Aspell, placed fourth. The trainer reported that the horse was never really travelling and would most likely be rested for the remainder of the season.

Race 2 – 3.05pm. THE LADBROKES BET IN LIVE IN PLAY HANDICAP

No enquiry.

The Stewards ordered the winner **CHAPEAU BLEU**, trained by Mrs C. Gilbert, ridden by Miss A. Mills to be routine tested.

Race 3 – 3.40pm. THE COUTTS FEATURE HANDICAP MILE

No Enquiry.

Race 4 – 4.15pm. THE LADBROKES LADIES DAY HANDICAP

No Enquiry.

The Stewards noted that Mr P. Prince, rider of **BLUE SEA OF IBROX** had pulled the horse up and dismounted. The jockey reported to the Starter that he thought the horse may have been lame. The Veterinary Officers inspected the horse but could on first sight see no evidence of lameness, they advised the trainer accordingly.

Race 5 – 4.50pm. THE LADBROKES BEST ODDS GUARANTEED HANDICAP

No Enquiry.

Post racing: The Stewards Secretary was advised by the Stewards to inform all trainers that any request to allow a horse to go the long way round to post, will mean that horse must leave the paddock first by a few minutes or last after others have paraded before the Judge.

The Stewards were also pleased with the newly introduced random passport checks in the Parade Ring conducted by the Veterinary Officers.

There being no further enquiries the Stewards were dismissed at 4.59 pm.
