Race 1 – 2.30pm. THE ARZAL MEMORIAL HANDICAP HURDLE

No enquiry.

Race 2 - 3.05 – THE EUROPEAN MEDITERRANEAN HORSE RACING FEDERATION HANDICAP SPRINT

Immediately after the race the Stewards reviewed the head on replay to consider possible interference between NATIONAL SERVICE, ridden by Mr P. Aspell, placed first and COUNTRY BLUE, ridden by Mr M. Batchelor, placed second. The Stewards concluded that the interference was minimal and did not affect the result. They considered that no riding offence had taken place and therefore took no further action.

Race 3 – 3.40pm. THE LA VALLETTE 2017 CLARENDON HANDICAP

The Stewards interviewed Mr P. Prince, the jockey of BLACK NIGHT, placed first, for improper riding in respect using his whip with excessive frequency inside the final two furlongs in breach of Rule 66(ii) and Instruction D of the Rules of Racing.

Having reviewed the official video the Stewards found Mr Prince guilty of improper riding in that he used his whip in excess of the permitted frequency on a horse that was clearly winning without good reason and fined him £50.

The Stewards ordered that BLACK NIGHT be routine tested.

Following the running of the third race the Stewards inspected the ground on the turn out of the back straight. The Stewards noted that the ground was cutting up and were advised by the Clerk of the Course that he had moved the rail so as to enable the use of a better patch of ground which had been dolled off during races 1 to 3. The Stewards were satisfied that the course was safe to race.


Race 4 – 4.15pm. THE GADGET GUYS 2017 “GLORY BEE” HANDICAP
