Prior to racing:

The Stewards and the Stewards Secretary walked the course and passed it fit.

Mrs. A. Malzard, trainer of **BEYOND MEASURE**, running in the first, and Mrs. A. Corson, trainer of **RAINBOW CHARLIE**, running in the third, requested that their horses be allowed into the Parade Ring last and to leave first.

Mr. K. Kukk, trainer of **ORDER OF SERVICE** and **LIMELITE**, both running in the third, requested that both be allowed to go to post the 'long way round'.

The Stewards after consideration granted all requested.

Race 1 – 2.30pm. THE KOKA FAST HANDICAP HURDLE

The Stewards noted that **MAJOR TOM**, trained by Mr K. Kukk, ridden by Mr. F. Tett pulled up and was attended to by the on-course Veterinary Officers.

The Senior Steward reported that Mrs. A Malzard trainer of **OCEAN CRYSTAL**, ridden by Mr. T. Clark, sent off favourite, had reported to him that the horse was 'unsuited by the ground'.

Race 5 – 4.50pm. THE BLOODSTOCK ADVISORY SERVICE HANDICAP

Having reviewed the official video and watched a head-on replay the Stewards interviewed Mr. P. Pilley, the jockey of **GREY PANEL**, trained by Mr. T. Le Brocq placed second and Mr. P. Prince, the jockey of **TELLOVOI**, trained by Mr. R. Guest, placed first, with regard to using the whip above the permitted frequency in breach of Rule 66(ii) and Instruction D of the Rules of Racing.

The Stewards found both guilty of improper riding in that they had used the whip with excessive frequency. Mr. Pilley was fined £50 and Mr. P. Prince was fined £100.

There being no further enquiries the Stewards were dismissed at 5.11 pm
