***Prior to racing:***

The Stewards and the Stewards Secretary walked the course and passed it fit.

Mr. K. Kukk, trainer of **BONJOUR**, running in the fourth, requested that horse be allowed on course early, reversed down the chute, mounted on course and led in at the start. The Stewards granted the requests and also allowed the horse be allowed to go to post directly without entering the Parade Ring or going before the Judge. The Stewards reminded Mr. Kukk where at the start he should be positioned. The Stewards Secretary sought permission from the Judge and the Starter for this to take place.

**Race 1 – 2.30pm. THE LADBROKES BETSTATION BONUS HANDICAP HURDLE**

**Race 2 – 3.05pm. THE LADBROKES SLOTS CASH BONUS HANDICAP**

Prior to the start of Race 2, Mr.K. Kukk asked if **Order of Service** could be mounted in the chute and proceed to the start the 'long way round', the Senior Steward duly granted his request.

**Race 3 – 3.40pm THE RAVENSCROFT LADIES DAY FEATURE HANDICAP**

The Steward at the start, Mr. G. Shenkin, brought to the attention of the Stewards that the owner of a runner in the race was seen on the race track just prior to the start. The Starter, Mr. D. Evans was interviewed and the recording of the race was reviewed. The Stewards then interviewed the trainer of the horse and reminded them that no was one allowed at the start with out permission of the Starter. The trainer was instructed to inform their owners that under no circumstances are they allowed on the racecourse at any point during a race without permission from the Starter or the Stewards. The Stewards Secretary will issue a note to the Jersey Race Club on this point as well.

**Race 4 – 4.15pm. THE LADBROKES LADIES DAY HANDICAP**

The Stewards enquired into the whip count of M. Quentin Jervais, placed first riding **HAWAIIAN FREEZE**, trained by Mr. J. Moon. Following a review of the recording of the tape, and interviewing M. Jervais, who was riding in the Channel Islands for the first time, they cautioned him as to his whip count. The Senior Steward instructed the Stewards Secretary to write to all trainers and remind them that it is their duty to inform their jockeys of this jurisdiction's rules.

The Stewards ordered the routine testing of **VEXILLUM**, trained by Mr. N. Mulholland, placed equal second and ridden by Mr. P. Apsell

**Race 5 – 4.50pm. THE LADBROKES GRID BEST ODDS GUARANTEED HANDICAP**

The Stewards interviewed Mr. Philip Prince, with regard to his outstanding fines. After an exchange of views, Mr. Prince deposited with the Stewards Secretary £50.
