Prior to Racing: Race 1, BRAC JAG to be led in; Race 2, ORDER OF SERVICE, Jockey to mount on course; LITTLE LOTTE and RAINBOW CHARLIE, permission given to enter the parade ring last, come out first and go straight to post;

Race 1 - 2.30pm. THE KOKA FAST HANDICAP HURDLE

The Stewards interviewed Alyson Malzard, the trainer of BRAC JAG, who had refused to race. The Trainer could offer no explanation for the gelding's behaviour. The Stewards issued BRAC JAG with its first warning.

Charlotte Prichard, the rider of BORN LEGEND which was pulled up, reported that the horse was off the bridle before the first flight and did not handle the ground.
Darragh Keogh, the rider of GREY GEM which was pulled up, reported that the horse did not handle the ground.

Race 2 - 3.05pm - THE LE VERTE RUE ASSOCIATES HANDICAP

The Stewards interviewed Mr Paddy Aspell, rider of GABSTER, trained by Mr Karl Kukk as to his whip action. Having interviewed the jockey and reviewed recordings of the race, the Stewards decided to take no further action.

Race 3 - 3.40pm. THE JERSERY BOOKMAKERS FEATURE HANDICAP

The Stewards postponed an interview with Mr Karl Kukk that was due to take place after racing until the next meeting due to the incident in Race 5.

Race 4 - 4.15pm. THE LIBERATION BREWERY HANDICAP

No enquiry.

Race 5 - 4.50pm. THE BLOODSTOCK ADVISORY SERVICE HANDICAP

The Stewards reviewed the incident on the final bend where by KOSHI fell and interfered with BROWN VELVET causing the rider to be unseated. The Stewards found that KOSHI had slipped on the final bend causing the incident. There being no riding offences under rules no further action was taken.
