Prior to Racing:

A. Corson, trainer of **Little Lottie** in the first race, requested permission for the horse to parade once around the paddock and go out to the course.

C. Gilbert, trainer of **Chapeau Blue** in the second race, requested permission to declare Serena Brotherton (who was in the air on a delayed plane) as jockey (as per the pre raceday declaration) and arrange a replacement to take the ride if the declared rider did not arrive within 15 minutes of the official start time. Note: Serena Brotherton arrived on course 16 minutes before the office start time.

A. Malzard, trainer of **Dark Moonlight** in the fifth race, requested permission (i) to mount the jockey early if the horse was unsettled in the paddock and go out to the course and (ii) for the horse to be led in from the second row if it was unsettled at the start.

Permission was granted to these requests, the final request being subject to the Starter's approval which was given.
