#### Non-Runners

Prior to Racing: Ms. C Gilbert requested that **JOE THE BEAU** running in the third race come into the parade ring late, do one circuit and then leave, with the jockey to mount in the shoot and go down to post first. The horse will pass the judge once and go all the way round the course, clockwise, to the 7f start.

Mrs. A. Corson requested that **LITTLE LOTTIE** running in the fifth be permitted to take leave the parade ring if she does not settle.

Mrs A. Malzard requested permission for **ISLAND SONG** to wear a red hood to the start.

The Stewards granted these requests.

#### **Race 1 - 2.30pm THE KOKA FAST HANDICAP HURDLE**

Nothing to report.

#### **Race 2 - 3.05PM THE BOOKMAKERS HANDICAP**

**N OVER J** unseated its rider S. Brotherton on the way to the start. The horse was caught and the rider remounted. The Vet confirmed that horse was fit to race. The Doctor subsequently examined S. Brotherton and confirmed that there were no issues.

#### **Race 3 - 3.40PM THE MYSUGARWATCH SPRING CUP**

**JOE THE BEAU** was mounted in the chute and unseated its rider S Brotherton at the entrance to the racecourse. The horse resisted being remounted and was withdrawn by the Stewards under rule (B)6.1.9. The Stewards subsequently interviewed the trainer Ms. C. Gilbert, who advised that its behaviour had been much better than last season, in its work both at home and on the course.

The Stewards informed the trainer that the behaviour of the horse must improve if it is to continue to race in the Channel Islands and it was given a first formal warning. It was suggested that if it is to race again, it should mounted on the course and not in the chute.

Immediately prior to the start **ZUHAIR** kicked **NOVEMBER RAIN**.

#### **Race 4 - 4.15pm THE LA VERTE RUE ASSOCIATES HANDICAP**

**RUBEUS** slipped and unseated its rider V. Malzard. The Vet confirmed that the horse was not injured.

#### **Race 5 - 4.50PM THE PRESIDENT'S EASTER HANDICAP**

Mr Horrigan stood down as a steward, being the owner of **DANCING MASTER** and the father of its rider.

**FOURNI** entered the parade ring without the declared cheek pieces. Whilst these were fitted in the parade ring, it resulted in a delay to the start.

#### **General Comment**

The Stewards noted a number of horses crossed the parade ring and remind trainers that this is not permitted by rule (B) 28.7. for safety reasons. Future breaches will be penalised in accordance with the Guide to Procedures and Penalties.
