Prior to Racing: The Stewards noted the change in going from the Wednesday declaration of Good, Good to Firm in Places to GOOD

The Stewards noted that the test of **ALLEGRO JET** had returned negative.

Ms. C Gilbert requested that **JOE THE BEAU**, running in the fourth to go to post last and not parade. It would be mounted in the 'horse lines area'.

Mrs A Malzard requested that **ARTHUR'S ANGEL**, also requested to go to post early, and **ISLAND SONG** wear hoods to the start.

The Stewards granted all requests and informed the Starter. They noted that owing to an administrative error **ARTHUR'S ANGEL** would wear a black hood.

No Enquiry. The Stewards requested the winning horse **ARTHUR'S ANGEL** be routine tested.

Race 4 - 3.45pm THE NICHE EVENTS HANDICAP

The Stewards enquired into the improved performance of the winner **DEVERELL**, trained by Mr J Moon and ridden by Perrine Cheyer. Having been priced at 16/1 on the rails and 55.5 at the Tote. The trainer reported that the horse was suited by the distance and the going.

The Stewards enquired into the refusal of **DARK MOONLIGHT**, trained by Mrs A Malzard and ridden by Isobel Francis to jump off. The rider reported that the horse didn't want to participate in the race, the Steward at the start concurred with this view. Mrs Malzard had to deal with an equine welfare issue and was unable therefore to present an explanation to the Stewards Room before they were dismissed for the day and the matter remains open.

Race 5 - 4.20PM THE LA VERTE RUE ASSOCIATES MARATHON HANDICAP

The Stewards enquired into possible interference at or about 1 ½ furlong from the finish, having reviewed recordings of the race and interviewed one of the riders involved. There being no offences under rules the Stewards took no further action.
