#### Non-Runners

Prior to Racing: Following an inspection of the course at 16.30 by the Chief Steward, Clerk of the Course and Groundsman, the going was changed from 'Good, Good to Firm in Places' to 'Firm, Good to Firm in Places'

Ms. C Gilbert requested that **JOE THE BEAU**, running in the second go to post first, be mounted in the horse lines, not parade and go to course via the inward chute. She also requested **DOONBERG FARMER** running in the same race go to post last and be mounted in the chute.

Mr. M. Quinlan on behalf of the trainer requested that **SIMPLY SIN** running in the third race be walked to post and mounted at the start.

Mrs A Malzard requested that **ISLAND SONG** and **ARTHUR'S ANGEL** both running in the fourth race wear red hoods to the start.

The Stewards granted all requests and informed the Starter.

#### **Race 2 - 7.05PM THE JRL GROUP SPRINT HANDICAP**

The Stewards noted that **JOE THE BEAU**, trained by Christa Gilbert, planted in the horse lines and was withdrawn by the trainer. The Stewards noted that the trainer's explanation that inclement weather was a mitigating factor. The Chief Steward concurred and noted that the horse had its jockey on board and was moving towards the chute when the course was hit by a very violent downpour. This unsettled the horse, as it did others in the Parade Ring, causing it possibly to refuse participate.

Following a fall on **DOONBEG FARMER** the rider Celine De La Haye was stood down for the rest of the meeting by the Racecourse Medical Officer.

#### **Race 3 - 7.40PM THE ABRDN HANDICAP**

The Stewards noted that Louise le Monnier replaced the booked rider Celine De La Haye on **KALANI ROSE** as she had been stood down.

The Stewards interviewed Mr M Quinlan rider of **SIMPLY SIN** who reported that the horse had enjoyed the better trip and had responded well to the distance.

**Race 4 - 8.15pm THE UBS HANDICAP**

The Stewards enquired into possible interference in the final furlongs. Having reviewed recordings of the race the Stewards took no further action

**Race 5 - 8.50PM THE RAYMOND FAMILY STAYERS HANDICAP**

Mr J. Horrigan stood down as a Steward for this race as his daughter was riding **DANCING MASTER.**
