Race 1 - 2.30pm THE GEORGE & LEONARA SULLIVAN HANDICAP HURDLE

Race 2 - 3.05PM THE POLYGON COLLECTIVE HANDICAP

The Stewards ordered an 'All Weigh' of riders. They also ordered the routine testing of **BUCKINGHAM** placed fourth.

Race 3 - 3.40PM THE JACKSONS 2023 JERSEY BULLET

The Stewards enquired into the whip count of Mr G. Wood rider of **AKKERINGA** and reminded him of the maximum count under CIHA rules.

Race 4 - 4.15pm THE LA VERTE RUE ASSOCIATES HANDICAP

Under rule B) 32.5 'In case of an emergency (such as an equipment failure)' the Starter reported that he would 'flag start' the race.

Christa Gilbert trainer of **COOL DANDY** was given permission for the horse to leave the parade ring early and led down to the start, jockey to mount either in the chute or on the course itself. Horse to be led into the start.

Race 5 - 4.50PM THE JRL GROUP HANDICAP

Mrs Malzard trainer of **JUST JERSEY** was given permission for the horse to enter the parade ring late, parade once and then go to post early.

The Stewards enquired into the running of **DANCING MASTER**, trained by Mr K Kukk and ridden by Miss C Horrigan. The rider was interviewed and reported that it was the horse's first time out in blinkers and that it had gone well whilst in front but had tired quickly when passed by other runners.

Post Racing:

The Stewards interviewed the Clerk of the Course, Mr J Cantle and Mr M Cummings with regards to the Hurdle Race, the number of attendants at each hurdle and the equipment required at each hurdle. The Stewards reminded them that there should be at least one attendant at each hurdle as well as orange discs that should be erected in front of any obstacle should the need arise. The Stewards instructed that a note be sent to the Jersey Race Club reminding them of Manual B) Rule 46 and in particular 46.3.1 and 46.3.2.
