The Jersey Race Club guarantees a minimum pool of £500 before deductions.

HOW TO PLAY

Select the first horse home in the selected 4 races on today's Race Card, that is races 2, 3, 4 and 5. Mark your selections on the Jackpot cards available at all Tote windows. Cards should be marked by filling the appropriate boxes in a similar way to entering a lottery card. Each Jackpot entry costs £1.00. Pass your card to a Tote operator before the second race.

RULES FOR JACKPOT BETTING

1.

Bets for the Jackpot must be placed prior to the off of the first race on which the Jackpot is operated. i.e. The second race.
2.

The operator, his officers or servants, shall not be liable if for any reason whatever, a Jackpot ticket is lost or mislaid.
3.

In the event of a dead heat for the first place in any of the selected races, the dead heating horses shall be deemed the winners of that selected race.
4.

If after completion of the selected races in the pool the winning combination or combinations are unbacked then the operator may at his discretion carry forward the net pool to be added either in whole or in such parts as the operator may determine to the net pool in a subsequent Jackpot pool.
5.

The dividend shall be calculated by dividing the net pool by the total number of units on the winning combinations of the selected races.
6.

Dividends shall be payable on the presentation of the appropriate winning ticket or tickets whole and not unreasonably defaced or unrecognisable.
7.

a)

If a horse is withdrawn from any of the selected races, then the ticket bearing the number of the withdrawn horse shall be deemed to contain in lieu thereof, the race card number of the horse running in that race upon which the greatest number of units has been staked in the Totalisator Win Pool operated on that race (the win pool favourite).

b)

If an equal number of units in such Win Pool has been staked on two or more horses running in that race and if the number is greater than the number of units staked in such Win Pool on any other runner in that race, then the ticket containing the race card number of any horse withdrawn as aforesaid from that race, shall be deemed to contain, in lieu thereof, the numerically lowest race card number of such equally backed horse.

c)

If for any reason it is, in the opinion of the operator, not possible to determine the number of the horse which should be substituted, every ticket containing the race card number of a horse withdrawn shall be deemed to contain in lieu thereof the race card number of such horse as may be determined by the operator.

8.

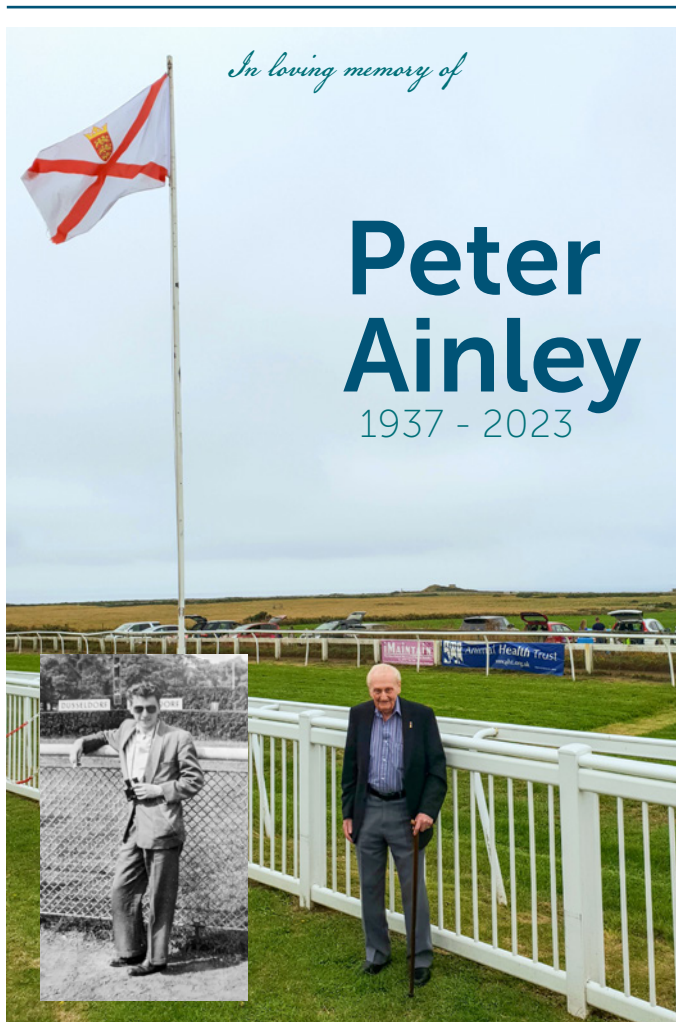
If one or more of the selected races in the Jackpot at any meeting is, for any reason, not run, not won, declared void or postponed to another race meeting each horse selected in the Jackpot for such race or races shall be deemed to be a winning horse and the remaining race or races will be deemed to form the Jackpot pool of that meeting.

9.

If for any reason less than the selected number of races in the pool is run then the dividend shall be calculated by dividing the net pool by the number of units on the winner of the last selected race in the pool which was run.

10.

In the event of a meeting being abandoned or postponed before the completion of the first selected race then the pool shall be cancelled and the total amount staked in the pool at the meeting shall be refunded on presentation of tickets.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- No children under 12 years or unauthorised persons may enter the parade ring, the pre-parade ring or the horse lines.
- Information on how to bet on the tote is displayed at the tote windows and in the marquees.
- Tote Jackpot bets can be placed at any tote window and in the marquee.
- Non-runners and jockey changes will be displayed on whiteboard by the tote.
- If you have any betting disputes please contact the betting ring steward, via the weighing room. Jackpot wins may be claimed up to 12 months from the date of the win. Apply to club secretary on tel. 863484.

## EACH-WAY BETTING TERMS

As a condition of their permission to trade at The CoinShares Racecourse at Les Landes the Bookmakers must follow the set industry standards for each-way betting.

***These are:***

- 2 to 4 Runners – Win only. Where a bookmaker wishes to depart from this default position they may offer place terms for 3 or 4 runners, this must be at 1/5 odds a place first 2.
- 5 to 7 Runners (inclusive) – 1/4 odds for finishing 1st or 2nd.
- 8 to 11 Runners – 1/5 odds for finishing 1st, 2nd or 3rd.
- 12 to 14 Runners in a Non Handicap – 1/5 odds for finishing 1st, 2nd or 3rd.
- 12 to 14 Runners in a Handicap – 1/4 odds for finishing 1st, 2nd or 3rd.

Bookmakers must display their betting terms at all times.

## CHAMPIONSHIPS 2023

There will be four championships run during the 2023 Channel Islands Racing Season.

Open to all registered trainers running horses in the Channel Islands.

Open to all jockeys riding in the Channel Islands.

- Champion rider and trainer will be based on most numbers of Winners during the current season.
- Races must be run by either the Jersey or Guernsey Race Clubs.
- If the race results in a dead-heat for first place, both winning Trainers/Riders will be credited with a winner.
- If at the end of the season two or more riders or trainers have an equal number of winners, the Championship will be decided on the most number of seconds.

Will be presented to the Channel Islands Owner of 2023 at the end of the Channel Islands racing season.  
It will be awarded to the owner who has won the most prize money. Only races run in the Channel Islands will qualify.

Will be presented to the Channel Islands Racehorse of the year at the end of the Jersey 2023 Racing Season. It will be awarded to the Racehorse gaining the most points in the year as follows:

1st = 9 Points • 2nd = 3 points • 3rd = 1 point

### An additional Championship for 2023 is The Polygon Collective Championship

This Championship is for middle distance races and has a qualifying race at each of our nine meetings where points are gained as follows:

1st = 10 Points • 2nd = 7 Points • 3rd = 4 Points • 4th = 2 Points

A £5000 prize will go to the horse with the most points at the end of the season.

CHAMPIONSHIPS 2023 FINAL DAY

The prizes for our five 2023 Championships get presented after racing today. The presentations will happen in the Presentation Area next to the winners enclosure and parade ring.

Two are already decided, one has a clear leader and two are going to the wire!

Alyson Malzard has retained her Trainers Championship title. She has had 19 winners so far. Alyson's best season to date was in 2010 when she had 25 winners. 22 were in Jersey and 3 in Guernsey that year. She will be hard pushed to beat the 22 Jersey winners in a season but does have runners in every race today. Karl Kukuk has had his best season to date with 11 winners so far, and with several fancied horses today he could well add to that.

Thanks to three wins each from Akkeringa and George Bancroft, and two from Sumatran Tiger, Hawk Racing have an unassailable lead in the Champion Owner standings. Hawk Racing have purchased good horses at very reasonable prices for the island and all four of their horses have leading chances today. Karl Kukuk trains all four of the Hawk Racing horses and deserves credit for keeping them all fresh and well for the whole season. The Joan Valerie May Trophy is the prize for this Championship.

Fred Tett is one winner away from securing the jockey's Championship, due to his eleven second places. With nine wins he is three ahead of Isobel Francis and four ahead of Victoria Malzard. There are only two scenarios that can see Fred beaten. The first is for Victoria to ride the winner in all five races and the other is for Isobel to win on all four of her mounts and Fred not to win the first race. Fred would be winning the Jockey's Championship for the second time having already won it in 2019. Fred rode 9 winners in 2019, so he will be keen to get at least another today to have his best season on Jersey.

The Polygon Collective Championship, which is in its first year of three, has two possible winners going into the ninth leg today. Never Said Nothing currently has 35 points and is 5 points ahead of Akkeringa, who has 30. With 10 points for a win, 7 for a second, 4 for a third and 2 for fourth either could claim the prize. Akkeringa will need to win with Never Said Nothing no better than third or finish second with Never Said Nothing no better than fifth to claim the Championship. Whereas Never Said Nothing needs to finish first or second, or anywhere in front of Akkeringa to claim it. If Akkeringa was second and Never Said Nothing fourth then the Championship would be tied on 37 points. All eyes on the feature race of the day The Polygon Collective Autumn Cup at 3:40pm for this exciting Championship finale.

The Champion Racehorse title, for the Eileen Le Quesne Amy Memorial Trophy, has six possible winners and Hawk Racing own three of them. The current leader is the P G Somers owned, Isaac D'Aubrelle with 37 points but he is on the sidelines with injury and unlikely to claim the Championship. Currently one point behind in second on 36 points are Hawk Racing's Akkeringa and Sheikh A'Leg Racing's homebred Allegro Jete. Sumatran Tiger, another for Hawk Racing, is fourth on 35 points and she runs against Allegro Jete today. The other two horses in contention but a little further a drift are the Simon and Florence Harrison-White owned four year old Profit And Loss (30 points) and Hawk Racing's hurdler George Bancroft (28 points). With 9 points for a win, 3 points for a second and 1 point for a third both would have to win and other results go for them. This Championship will go to the final race of season as both Allegro Jete and Sumatran Tiger are declared for that race. They are many permutations for this Championship and commentator Felix Wheeler will keep you all updated as the day pans out.

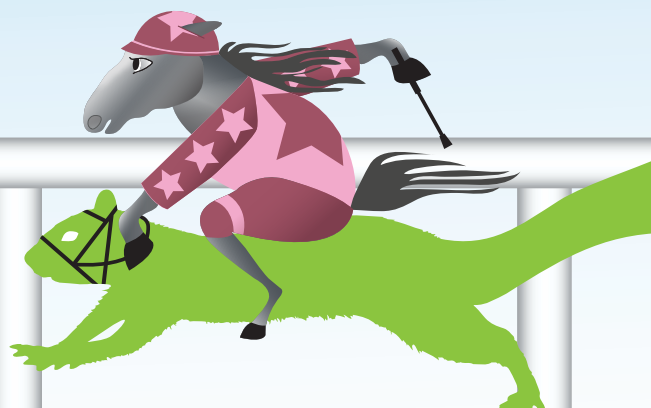
