**Prior to Racing:**

The Stewards noted that the results from the routine test of **ROI DU MONDE**, trained by Alyson Malzard came back negative, the trainer was duly informed.

Alyson Malzard trainer of **COOL DANDY** requested that the horse be allowed to leave the parade ring early and be mounted on the course. The Stewards granted this request.

The Stewards noted that the weather was unseasonal and the meteorological conditions may impact race timings.
