Prior to Racing:

The Stewards noted that the results from the routine test of **ZUHAIR**, trained by Karl Kukk came back negative, the trainer was duly informed.

Celine De La Haye trainer of **BIRKIE BOY**, running in the second, & **NATURE**, running in the fifth requested that the horses be led in. This was granted and the trainer reminded that the horses should be led in second row.

Alyson Malzard trainer of **COOL DANDY,** running in the third, and **MAQUIGNON**, running in the fourth, requested that the horse be allowed to leave the parade ring early and be mounted on the course. The Stewards granted this request.

Paul Gallagher, rider of **NAN BRADY**, running in the fourth, was unable to ride due to an injury sustained earlier that day and was therefore stood down.

The incident that was brought to the attention of the Stewards after the last meeting had closed was considered by the Stewards, it was felt appropriate to remind all participants that conduct within the vicinity of the public should be restrained.

The Stewards noted a patch of soft ground just before the 4 furlong marker, all participants were asked to ride wide of that area as it was not possible to doll out due to the narrow width of the course at that point.
