TOTE JACKPOT BETTING PICK 4

You must be 18 years or older to use the Tote.

The Jersey Race Club deductions from the Tote Race Pools are:

Win & Place = 20% Exacta = 25% Jackpot = 29%

Win Pool - Betting on horse to win.

Place Pool - Betting on horse to place.

Places paid:

2 to 4 runners – Win Only

5 to 7 runners – 1st and 2nd places paid

8 to 14 runners – 1st, 2nd and 3rd places paid.

EXACTA

Betting on horses to finish 1st and 2nd on races with 3 runners or more.

JACKPOT

The Jersey Race Club guarantees a minimum pool of £500.

HOW TO PLAY THE JACKPOT

Select the first horse home in the selected 4 races on the racecard, races 2, 3, 4 and 5. Place your jackpot bets with any tote operator. Each Jackpot entry costs £1. Jackpots bets must be placed before the second race with a tote operator.

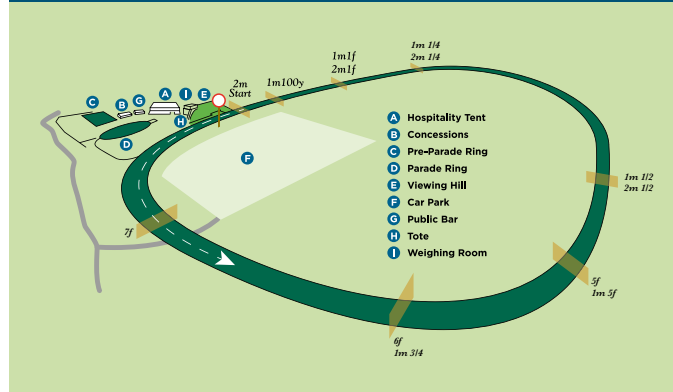
Permutations

You can enhance your chances by selecting more than one horse in any race. To calculate the cost of permutations, simply multiply the number of selections in each race.

RULES FOR JACKPOT BETTING

1. Bets for the Jackpot must be placed prior to the off of the first race on which the Jackpot is operated. i.e. Race Two.
2. The operator, his officers or servants, shall not be liable if for any reason whatever a Jackpot ticket is lost or mislaid.
3. In the event of a dead heat for the first place in any of the Jackpot races, the dead heating horses shall be deemed the winners of that Jackpot race.
4. If after completion of the Jackpot races, no Jackpot entrant has selected the winners of the four races the pool will be carried forward to the next meeting or a meeting of the operator's choice.
5. The dividend shall be calculated by dividing the net pool by the total number of bets which have correctly selected the winners of all four races.
6. Dividends shall be payable on the presentation of the appropriate winning ticket or tickets whole and not unreasonably defaced or unrecognisable.
7. Should a selection be a non-runner it will be substituted with the horse on which the greatest number of tote win units have been staked (the win pool favourite). In the event of there being equal win pool favourites, the horse with the lowest racecard number will be substituted for the non-runner.
8. If one or more of the selected races in the Jackpot at any meetings is, for any reason, not run, not won, declared void or postponed to another race meeting each horse selected in the Jackpot for such race or races shall be deemed to be a winning horse and the remaining race or races will be deemed to form the Jackpot pool of that meeting.
9. If for any reason less than the selected number of races in the pool is run then the dividend shall be calculated by dividing the net pool by the number of units on the winner of the last selected race in the pool which was run.
10. In the event of a meeting being abandoned or postponed before the completion of the first selected race then the pool shall be cancelled and the total amount staked in the pool at the meeting shall be refunded on presentation of tickets.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- No children under 12 years or unauthorised persons may enter the parade ring, the pre-parade ring or the horse lines.
- Information on how to bet on the tote is displayed at the tote windows and in the marquees.
- Tote Jackpot bets can be placed at any tote window and in the marquee.
- Non-runners and jockey changes will be displayed on whiteboard by the tote.
- If you have any betting disputes please contact the betting ring steward, via the weighing room. Jackpot wins may be claimed up to 12 months from the date of the win. Apply to club secretary on tel. 863484.

EACH-WAY BETTING TERMS

As a condition of their permission to trade at The CoinShares Racecourse at Les Landes the Bookmakers must follow the set industry standards for each-way betting.

These are:

2 to 4 Runners – Win only. Where a bookmaker wishes to depart from this default position they may offer place terms for 3 or 4 runners, this must be at 1/5 odds a place first 2.

5 to 7 Runners (inclusive) – ¼ odds for finishing 1st or 2nd.

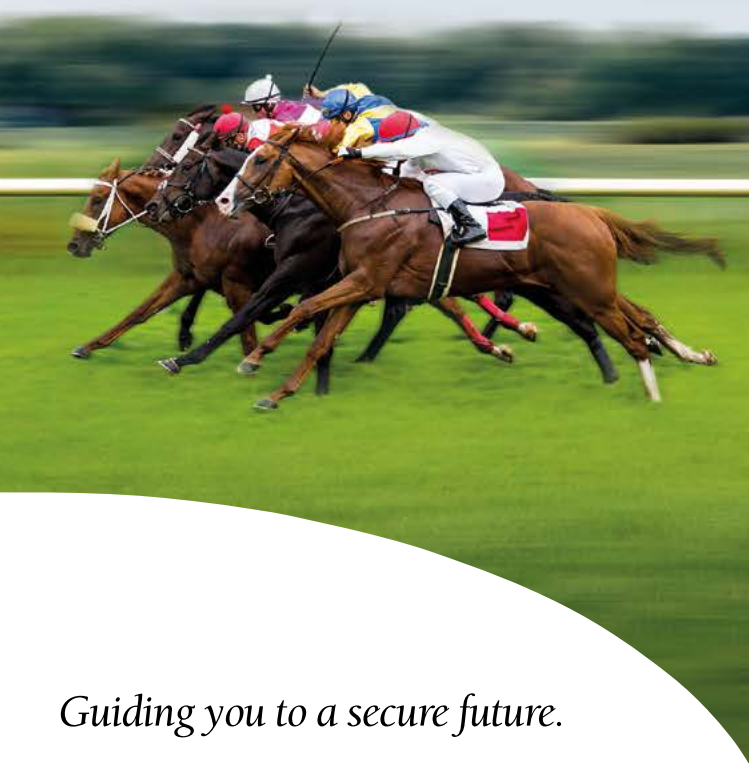
8 to 11 Runners – 1/5 odds for finishing 1st, 2nd or 3rd.

12 to 14 Runners in a Non Handicap – 1/5 odds for finishing 1st, 2nd or 3rd.

12 to 14 Runners in a Handicap – ¼ odds for finishing 1st, 2nd or 3rd.

Bookmakers must display they betting terms at all times.

Six wins from ten hurdle races at Les Landes but beaten comfortably the last twice by Diplomatie. Fell early in last year's Champion Hurdle when second favourite. Today's race has potentially been his target all season so is not easily dismissed. Is lowest rated in the race but on his best form can be competitive.

Level weights today so should reverse form with that horse. Won the Clarendon Handicap on the flat off topweight last time. Looks a strong contender here today.

Beat Princess T off level weights in a Conditions Hurdle on 11th August and comfortably beat George Bancroft and Bigup when racing off topweight in a handicap last time. She is the clear form pick but form can sometimes be thrown upside down in Championship races. Is yet to race against Man Of The Sea over hurdles and is weighted to finish very close to him.

The defending Channel Islands Champion Hurdler who has had two hurdle and two flat runs at Les Landes so far this season. She won over hurdles at the first meeting on 12th May when having a fitness edge over three local runners. Her other hurdle run was when beaten by Diplomatie on 11th August off level weights and Diplomatie has gone on to win again since. She was beaten by 8 lengths that day and will do well to reverse the form with that rival.

Betting Forecast: 7/4 Man Of The Sea, 5/2 Princess T, 3/1 Diplomatie, 5/1 George Bancroft, 10/1 Big Up

Grosnez Gamble: A competitive renewal of the Channel Islands Champion Hurdle with four out of the five having good chances. GEORGE BANCROFT's form has tailed off recently and his rating suggests he should not be winning. DIPLOMATIE on the other hand has improved and won her last three. Neil Mulholland has a fine record with hurdlers at Les Landes and it is likely with two runners that he and Champion Owners, Dajam Ltd will take home the prize. Which one will win is tough to call but if **MAN OF THE SEA** repeats his performance of last time he could be the one. PRINCESS T is best in on ratings but looks held by DIPLOMATIE. There is an exacta rollover for this race so a bigger than normal pool is there to be won. The suggested Exacta is Man Of The Sea to beat Diplomatie.

Timetodock has won both of those 5f races but they were both handicaps where this fella was giving over a stone in weight each time. The clear form pick but starts in 5f races can be so important, so this is no penalty kick! Has proven himself the best sprinter on the island by comfortably winning the Polygon Collective Championship this season.

If today's race was a handicap he would be receiving 21lbs from Profit And Loss. Looking for his first win since June 2022 and is on a 17 run losing streak. Would be a surprise winner.

Grosnez Gamble: The Championship race for the speedsters in which a good start is usually essential. Alyson Malzard has won every 5f and 6f race this season, so the winner is very likely to come from her three runners. PROFIT AND LOSS is the clear best on ratings and if all goes to plan he will win. Sprint races can be won and lost at the start and the most reliable starter in the field is **TIMETODOCK**. He is selected to get away fast and build up a big enough lead to hold off the fast finishing PROFIT AND LOSS, like he has twice already this season.

Did not look that day in need of the extra two furlongs he runs over today and could struggle against proven stayers.

On ratings he has little chance but the handicapper has rated him on his hurdles form and he could easily prove better on the flat. Has a clear liking for Les Landes, as he has two wins and a second from three hurdle runs. Falls into the unknown category but from his one completed start here this season, when second to Diplomatie over hurdles, he should be held by Roi Du Monde and Sumatran Tiger.

Highest rated horse in the race and should take all the beating.

Looks to be massively outclassed but can run on to pick up place prizemoney with today's smaller field, as she is a proven stayer.

Looked to be outstayed in the Jersey Derby by Roi Du Monde and may struggle to reverse that form today. Also rested at the last meeting to be fresh for today.

CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024

2024 Channel Islands Championships

There will be six championships run during the 2024 Channel Islands Racing Season

Channel Islands Champion Trainer

Open to all registered trainers running horses in the Channel Islands

Channel Islands Champion Jockey

Open to all jockeys riding in the Channel Islands

- Champion jockey and trainer will be based on the most number of winners during the current season.
- Races must be run by either the Jersey or Guernsey Race Clubs under the rules of The Channel Islands Horseracing Authority.
- If the race results in a dead-heat for first place, both winning trainers/jockeys will be credited with a winner.
- If at the end of the season two or more jockeys or trainers have an equal number of winners, the Championship will be decided on the most number of seconds and then thirds.

Channel Islands Owner of The Year for The Joan Valerie May Trophy

It will be awarded to the owner who has won the most prize money.

- Only races run in the Channel Islands will qualify.
- If at the end of the season two or more owners have an equal amount of prize money, the Championship will be decided on the most number of race wins, then seconds and then thirds.

Channel Islands Racehorse of The Year for The Eileen Le Q. Amy Memorial Trophy

It will be awarded to the racehorse gaining the most points in the year as follows:

1st = 9 points, 2nd = 3 points, 3rd = 1 point

If at the end of the season two or more racehorses have an equal number of points, the Championship will be decided on the most number of race wins, then seconds and then thirds.

The 2024 Polygon Collective Championship

This Championship is for sprint races and has a qualifying race at each of our nine race meetings where points are gained as follows:

1st = 10 points, 2nd = 7 points, 3rd = 4 points, 4th = 2 points

A £5,000 prize will go to the racehorse with the most points at the end of the season.

2024 Best Turned Out Championship

In every race at all fixtures this season the groom who prepares his or her horse and leads it up in the pre-race parade is judged on the way the horse is turned out.

Every aspect is considered, does the horse look well brushed with a gleaming coat? Have the mane and tail been carefully combed out? Are the hooves clean and oiled? And is the tack clean and properly in place? Some judges are impressed by a carefully plaited mane, a task which can take hours, other prefer a more natural look.

As the horses leave the parade ring the decision is made and the groom judged to have done the best job is rewarded with a £100 prize. It's an indication that the work of these unsung heroes and heroines of the local sport has not gone unnoticed.

In a new initiative there is a season long competition to find the winner of the most best-turned-out awards and he or she will collect an additional prize of £500. As you watch the runners led around before each race pause for a moment to consider how these thoroughbreds are so well cared for by the stable staff who do not only the race day work, but plenty of behind-the-scenes hard work.

2024 CHAMPIONSHIPS UPDATE

At the end of the meeting in the Presentation Area on the edge of the Parade Ring the 2024 Championship Prizes will be awarded to the winners.

The Trainer's Championship has already been won by Alyson Malzard. She has 18 winners so far this season and needs two more to surpass her total of 19 from last season.

The Owner's Championship is not mathematically over but Dajam Ltd have one hand on the trophy already. Their season's earnings so far are £23,720 and they have runners in three races today. Only Hawk Racing can catch them but it would mean them winning all four races they have runners in!

The Champion Racehorse could be one of three horses. Diplomatie and Man Of The Sea both sit 6 points behind Profit And Loss (36) on 30 points. With 9 points for a win should either Diplomatie or Man Of The Sea win the Champion Hurdle then Profit And Loss would need to win the Jersey Bullet to be successful. If Profit And Loss was second, and get the 3 points for doing so, after one of them winning the Champion Hurdle then the Champion Hurdler would win owing to the fact they would have four wins during the season against Profit And Loss's three. If neither Diplomatie or Man Of The Sea win then Profit And Loss will add the Champion Racehorse title to the Polygon Collective Championship, which he has already secured prior to today.

The Jockey's Championship is extremely close and like the Champion Horse title could go one of three ways. Victoria Malzard currently leads Fred Tett due to having five second place finishers to Fred's four. They both currently have seven winners. If they end up tied on first and seconds it would go down to third places where Fred currently leads Victoria eight to seven. Also in the mix is Raul Da Silva, who has four strong contenders from the Karl Kukk yard. Raul is currently two wins behind on five but with nine second place finishers would just need to tie on wins to claim the Championship. There is every chance the Championship could go to the last race and all three have a ride in the race. If Victoria and Fred end up joint top with the same amount of firsts, seconds and thirds then the title would be shared.
