The vet reported that the horse was sound. The course was inspected and a hole was found at the 7f bend which was filled. The trainer Alyson Malzard reported that the horse was gangly and green.

Prior to the start of the race **MISS SPARKALOT** trained by James Moon became unsettled in the parade ring and was given permission to be lead out and go onto course early. The horse continued to remain unsettled once on course. Having come under starters orders, the horse failed to jump off with the rest of the field and was dismounted and removed from the course.

Prior to the start an altercation occurred between James Moon, trainer of **MISS SPARKALOT** and a race day Steward. The matter has been referred to the Head Office of the Channel Island Horseracing Authority.

Stewards ordered the routine testing of the winner of the race, **BANK ON KENT**, trained by Alyson Malzard.
