Prior to Racing:

John Hamilton, Head of Equine Welfare raised concerns with the Jersey Race Club as to predicted temperature and weather conditions on race day. Stewards noted that the high temperature were of concern to equine welfare and resolved to work with the Jersey Race Club to monitor the conditions accordingly. The Raceday Going Report from the Clerk of the Course stated; "a light north-easterly breeze is keeping temperatures feeling cooler, with winds forecast to strengthen later in the day.". The Stewards resolved to remain vigilant and monitor the situation throughout the day. The temperature at 4.30pm had dropped to 26.5 degrees with a force four north-easterly cooling breeze.

The Clerk of the Scales requested that due to the heat, the jockeys were allowed an additional 3lb allowance at the scales in order to consume water under Rule (B)22.9

Horse no.1 CUEROS fell on the final bend suffering a catastrophic open fracture of the left cannon bone. The horse was euthanized at the scene. The jockey was uninjured but was attended by the doctor.

The Clerk of the Scales reported to the Stewards that the jockey Victoria Malzard reported that the horse lost its footing prior to the fall.



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The Stewards had a debrief with the course Vets, a number of areas of concern were identified and referred up for further investigation. Some of these concerns were shared with members of the Jersey Race Club committee and it was agreed to have a full debrief meeting scheduled for the week ahead.

A further debrief has held with the Clerk of the Course to check on his wellbeing and to advise that a full debrief will be held next week.
